



# RESCUE *Live!*

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- ***Why is the Rescue Revival not held in a Church?*** Simply put it's an easier threshold to cross. The Rescue Revivals are tremendous opportunities to not only preach the gospel to those in the pews, but also to those who have fallen away or who are unchurched. Hosting a revival at an event center creates an invitational opportunity for those who may not otherwise come to a church event. Additionally, given the size and scope of the revival, most parishes are not equipped to bring a revival to their campus.
- ***Why are small groups so important?*** An essential part of the day is not only hearing the gospel but having the opportunity to discuss it with others. Small groups allow for conversation, food and friendship throughout the course of the day.
- ***How much does the Rescue Revival cost?*** ACTS XXIX is only reimbursed for travel and lodging. Event costs will vary depending on the venue, technology set-up, food, and the funds raised to subsidize the event in order to make it as affordable as possible.
- ***How do you suggest we best promote this?*** It's foundational to engage promotional partners, such as local Catholic radio, Catholic newspapers, or a Catholic Foundation to help spread the word. Additionally, reaching out to parishes and schools in the diocese is another way to market and promote the revival.
- ***What is the ideal size for a Rescue Revival?*** It works best to have a crowd large enough to build excitement but not too large that we cannot accommodate tables in the round for small groups. Our experience suggests that the target is somewhere between 1,000-3,000.
- ***What meals are provided?*** Breakfast, lunch and some sort of light snack mid-afternoon are ideal.
- ***Is there a Eucharistic procession?*** Ideally, yes. The procession near the end of the day offers a graced opportunity for people to respond to the Lord and surrender to Jesus anew or for the first time.
- ***Is Mass a part of the day?*** For various reasons, our experience is that it is best not to offer Mass as part of the revival. We'll be happy to share why in a conversation if you'd like.
- ***Are confessions offered?*** No. Unlike a men's or women's conference, it's important to not miss any of the preaching. Hopefully, people will be eager to go to confession after the revival.
- ***Is worship provided by ACTS XXIX?*** Worship is an integral part of the day. We have worship leaders that we partner with, but are open to having a conversation with you about this.
- ***What are the key A/V needs?*** These revivals require a high degree of technical support. As the preaching relies heavily on visuals, large high quality screens are imperative for unobstructed visibility. Likewise, both the preaching and worship require excellent sound capability.
- ***Are marketing templates available?*** Yes and we'd be happy to share them with you.
- ***Are outlines of the day available?*** Yes! We'll be happy to share them with you once we have a conversation with you.
